Senior Eligibility Requirements

What is Bright Futures?

- Academic Scholarship offered to all FLORIDA residence students who qualify.
- You MUST apply for the scholarship by completing the FFAA (website below)
- All scores (ACT, SAT, PERT) will be considered through high school graduation
- If you qualified, you will receive Bright Future funding your first year in college and the scholarship will renew each year as long as student maintains required GPA and earns required credit hours.
- There are two main levels of Bright Futures: FAS & FMS. For both levels, high school students must meet the following requirements:
